TEAMSTERS JOINT COUNCIL 80 ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND APPLICATION CRITERIA:

Teamsters Joint Council 80 will award TWO (2) scholarships per year in the amount of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) each. The scholarships will be awarded on or about June 30th of every year. The recipients will be chosen in a non partisan manner based upon satisfactory scholastic ratings. The payment of the Scholarship Awards will be issued directly to the recipients upon proof of college registration for full time attendance. Should the applicants withdraw from college enrollment following this scholarship award, it shall be deemed forfeited. The scholarship awards are available to **High School Graduating Senior students ONLY**. All applicants must comply with the eligibility and application criteria.

EACH APPLICANT MUST:

1. Be the CHILD of an ACTIVE MEMBER (Parent, Step Parent / Guardian) who has been in Good Standing for a twelve month period with a Teamsters Local Union affiliated with TEAMSTERS JOINT COUNCIL 80; or be the CHILD of a DECEASED MEMBER who had Good Standing status for a twelve month period prior to their death with a Teamsters Local Union affiliated with TEAMSTERS JOINT COUNCIL 80;
2. Be a graduating High School **Senior**;
3. Submit SAT/ACT scores or other academic testing for evaluation;
4. Submit a current transcript of grades achieved in High School;
5. Plan to attend an accredited TWO (2) or FOUR (4) year College.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Complete the Scholarship Application and Forward to TEAMSTERS JOINT COUNCIL 80 by May 31st at 1007 JONELLE STREET, DALLAS, TEXAS, 75217.
2. Along with your completed Application, additional information will be required:
 - a) Official High School Transcript including your class rank;
 - b) ACT or SAT scores,
 - c) Proof of Teamster PARENT/STEP PARENT/GUARDIAN membership status; AND
 - d) A brief essay offering your academic strengths, listing any offices and positions of leadership you have held, work experience, career objectives; an non academic interests/activities including political, cultural and social.

NO EMPLOYEE AND NO RELATED FAMILY MEMBER OF AN EMPLOYEE WORKING FOR ANY LOCAL UNION THAT IS AFFILIATED WITH TEAMSTERS JOINT COUNCIL 80 SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR THIS AWARD.
